

# Psalm 110 in the NT

## Enthronement:

Heb 1:3: The Son  
"sat down at the  
right hand of the  
Majesty on high"

Heb 1:13: God  
never said this to  
an angel, but to  
the Son.

Heb 8:1: Jesus is seated at  
the right hand of the throne  
of the Majesty in heaven.

Heb 10:12-13: Jesus "sat  
down at the right hand of  
God, waiting...until his  
enemies be made a  
footstool for his feet."

Heb 12:2: Jesus is  
seated at the right  
hand of the throne of  
God

## Melchizedek:

Heb 5:6: God says this to the Son.  
5:10  
6:20  
7:11  
7:15  
7:17

Heb 7:21: Entire  
verse quoted,  
including the oath.

A Psalm of David.

1 The LORD says to my Lord:  
"Sit at My right hand  
Until I make Your enemies a footstool for Your  
feet."

2 The LORD will stretch forth Your strong scepter from  
Zion, saying,  
"Rule in the midst of Your enemies."

3 Your people will volunteer freely in the day of Your  
power;  
In holy array, from the womb of the dawn,  
Your youth are to You as the dew.

4 The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind,  
"You are a priest forever  
According to the order of Melchizedek."

5 The Lord is at Your right hand;  
He will shatter kings in the day of His wrath.

6 He will judge among the nations,  
He will fill them with corpses,  
He will shatter the chief men over a broad country.

7 He will drink from the brook by the wayside;  
Therefore He will lift up His head.

Luke 20:42-43:  
Jesus asks how  
the messiah can  
be David's son,  
since David calls  
him Lord. (Mark  
12:36, Matt 22:44)

Acts 2:34-35.  
Peter says this  
cannot apply to  
David, who did  
not ascend into  
heaven.

Matt. 26:64,  
Jesus combines  
this with Daniel 7

Eph. 1:20  
Col. 3:1  
1 Cor 15:25  
Eph. 1:22  
1 Pet 3:22

Note: Psalm 110:1 takes on special significance in combination with Psalm 2 and Daniel 7
